Activities underway or completed since the last report:

- The committee has a number of bills to consider via Derek. We were not able to get to them all in our regular committee meeting, and a Quick Response Team meeting is set for 5/29 to discuss the remaining bills and screen for which items should be brought back to the committee.
- We continue to discuss member concerns:
 - Budget years for district libraries
 - Standardizing number of board members throughout stats (7 vs 9)
 - Monitoring the U.S. Citizenship Act of 2021 with regards to official language for subject headings
 - o Librarians being considered in Phase 1b of vaccination rollout

- Finalize stance of Illinois bills relating to libraries and determine actions needed, if any
- Discuss the need for a PPC handbook outlining expectations for potential committee members
- Begin to generate ideas for legislative proposals for 2022
