Due to the diminishing access to our legislature due to the impacts of COVID-19, and the defeat of the Fair Tax amendment and subsequent uncertainty about the IL budget, PPC has officially shifted its focus from the legislative priorities presented to the board previously and will prioritizing larger goals that will be focus on:

- Demonstrating the value of libraries
- Advocating for input in state guidance
- Retaining full library funding.

The previous priorities set forth by PPC will still be acted upon should a clear and manageable opportunity arise
