Activities underway or completed since the last report:

- Career Pathway Talk Series: The second webinar in this series, focusing on public librarianship, was held on January 27, 2021. Feedback was generally positive. The final talk for this year will be on March 31, 2021.
- Kyra Lee became the forum's third co-manager in February of 2021. She will serve through January of 2023.
- Leslie Lopez Holder continued working on increasing the forum's social media presence and creating a plan and schedule for social media.
- The forum decided to hold a vote for a revision of the by-laws concerning how long comanagers' terms should last. The deadline for the vote was March 15th.

Projected activities/initiatives during the upcoming months:

- Host the third Career Pathway Talk Series, focused on non-traditional librarian careers, on March 31, 2021.
- Complete a hard membership push.
- Plan the next series of Career Pathway Talk sessions, expanding to topics such as networking and the current job market.
