The public has also been able to vote at each level in the People's Choice bracket, and that contest is down to *Last Night at the Telegraph Club* by Malinda Lo vs. *Himawari House* by Harmony Becker. The <u>final round</u> for both brackets will be chosen by vote. <u>Voting is open</u> until May 12 at 10 a.m.
