- ☐ Purpose of the collection
- ☐ Responsibility for collection management
- ☐ Parameters of the collection, including subject areas, formats, etc.
- ☐ Criteria for selection, replacement, and withdrawal (weeding)
- ☐ Gifts and Donations
- ☐ Local Authors
- ☐ Procedure for public requests for collection additions
- ☐ Procedure for reconsideration of materials
- ☐ Statement that Collection Management Policy will be reviewed every two years (75 ILCS 5/4-7.2)
