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



Determining a digitization project



Project

"one and done"

- finite: start and end date
- specific collection or types of items
- independent activity
- one time grant/funding

Program

"big picture"

- long-term planning
- collaborative
- iterative development of
 - workflows
 - standards
 - tools
 - documentation


Planning for Sustainability

Digitization Projects: Not Just Scanning





DEWELL AND

In-House Digitization

Pros

- Good for fragile or specialty materials
- Keeps material on site
- Builds new skills
- Saves money?

Cons

- Requires expertise, space, specialty tools
- Slower production
- Less sophisticated hardware/software
- One-time staff leave with their expertise

Equipment

Hardware:

- 2D objects: Flatbed scanner
- 3D objects: Camera
- Audio/Video: Conversion device

Software:

- Image editing—Photoshop (\$), GIMP (OS)
- OCR (Optical Character Recognition)—ABBYY
 FineReader (\$), Tesseract (OS)
- Audio editing—Audacity (OS) ...
- Video editing—iMovie (Mac), Premiere Pro (\$)...

Outsourcing

Pros

- Specialized staff & equipment process lots of awkward material, fast!
- Custom, uniform output
- Staff can focus on description & subject context

Cons

- Material leaves repository
- Less capacitybuilding at host organization
- Unsupervised quality control

Conversion: Best Practice

- High quality and high resolution Master copy
- Derive lower resolution copy for web delivery
- Convert to web-friendly formats and sizes
- Capture all content for full-text search

- e.g. Images
- Master copy 300dpi lossless TIFF file (colour or greyscale
 - not B&W)
- Upload 300dpiJPEG or JP2000

Digital File Management

- Tracking
- File naming best practices
- Metadata Application Profile (MAP)
- Storage



- User friendly public & data management
- Interactive options for community
- Optimized for web discovery
- Sustainable long term

After digitization

- How will users access your collections?
- How will users discover your collections?
- How will users interact with your collections?

Ensure Discovery

- Metadata (Description)
- Full text or Transcription
- Contextual tools (exhibits, timelines, etc)
- Optimization
- Sharing and Contribution options
- Promotion



Measuring Impact

- Quantitative:
 - Site traffic analytics audience count,
 geographic reach, popular searches, referrals
 - On-site activity number of comments/contributions, in-person interactions generated
- Qualitative
 - Testimonials, 3rd party mentions, in-house usage
